QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS:

On the submission of ongoing government and private contracts:

- 1. Is the Bidder required to submit copies of the contracts or just the matrix of their ongoing contracts?
 - The Bidder/s shall submit the certified true copies of the applicable Contract, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed of the ongoing contracts indicated in the submitted statement on bid submission.

On the PADPAO Rate/Administrative Fee/PhilHealth Premium Rate:

- 1. What will the bidder use, is it PADPAO rate or the administrative fee stated under DOLE 150-16?
- 2. Will the bidder be disqualified if they bid below 20%?
- 3. What will the bidder use for PhilHealth Contribution, is it the 3% or the 4% premium rate since there is a new ruling for the PhilHealth contribution.
 - > Section VII. Technical Specifications clearly provided the following:
 - Strict adherence to the Philippine Association of Detective and Protective Agency Operators (PADPAO) prescribed rates for: (1) Amount to Guard; and (2) Amount to Government in favor of Guards, as of 01 January 2021. (PhilHealth premium contribution to be used is 3%.)
 - Rate for Agency/Administrative Fees must comply with existing labor laws and standards.

A. SCOPE OF OBLIGATIONS/ RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 17) All bid prices for the duration of one (1) year shall be fixed and shall not be adjusted during contract implementation, except for the following:
 - a) Increase in taxes;
 - b) Increase in any of the following pursuant to law or lawful issuance, should it happen after date of bidding:
 - Wage order;
 - SSS contributions;
 - Pag-Ibig Fund contributions;
 - · Philhealth contributions; and
 - ECC contributions.
- ➤ If bids are not in accordance with the above-stated provision, the bidder shall be disqualified.

On the submission of Certification from SSS of no delinquency in payments of monthly premiums as of October 31, 2021:

- 1. Will PHILGUARANTEE accept SSS monthly remittance of contributions of up to October 2021 instead of the required certification of no delinquency in payments of monthly premium?
 - > The bidder must submit the required certification up to October 2021, and may also submit the proof of monthly remittance in support of the certification. The bidders shall be evaluated on the basis of compliance on the payments of monthly premiums/contributions only.

On the submission of Certificate from the National Labor Relations Commission that the service provider has no adverse decided case in areas where the security agency has an on-going or completed contract/s as of October 31, 2021:

- 1. Would a certificate of no pending case on the arbiter's level and a certificate of no pending case on appeal on the commissioner's level from the National Labor Relations Commission (NLRC) suffice to comply with PHILGUARANTEE's requirement to submit a certificate from the NLRC of no adverse decided case?
 - A certificate of no pending case on the arbiter's level and a certificate of no pending case on appeal on the commissioner's level from NLRC may be submitted in lieu of the certificate from the NLRC of no adverse decided case.

On the form for the prices schedule:

- 1. There is no form provided for the prices schedule.
 - ➤ The form for the prices schedule is provided on Page 48 of the bidding documents.
 - ➤ The Bidder/s shall accomplish and submit the attached Cost Distribution Form together with the Bid Form and Price Schedule.
